




The dashboard, which students are first shown on page load




The audit view, which shows students their progress on degree requirements and allows them to easily make changes and see their impact.




The 4 year plan view, which allows students to plot out which semester they will take their classes. Students can drag courses to terms where the course is offered.




Any course can be clicked on to view catalog info, plan status, and see its offering pattern.




The semester tab allows students to plan the specific sections for each semester (even years in advance). They can download this schedule into their calendar as well.




Students can browse courses by department and filter down to see only courses offered in a specific term




Students can browse areas of study by department and click on them to learn more or add to their plan
