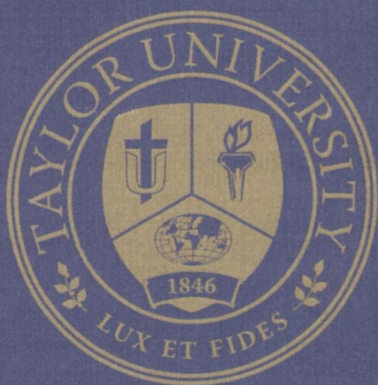

PAIGE COMSTOCK CUNNINGHAM, PHD, JD, began her role as Interim President of Taylor University on August 18, 2019. She served as a Taylor Trustee for 17 years, most recently as Board Chair.

Beyond her service at Taylor, Cunningham has extensive academic, scholarship, and professional qualifications for her new position, with significant experience in bioethics, public policy, and prolife issues.

Dr. Cunningham graduated from Taylor University and earned her JD from Northwestern University Law School, MA in Bioethics from Trinity International University (TIU), and PhD (Educational Studies) from Trinity Evangelical Divinity School. Cunningham was most recently the Executive Director of The Center for Bioethics & Human Dignity (TIU) and an affiliate professor at Trinity Law School and Trinity Graduate School. She was an adjunct instructor at Wheaton College for eight years and serves on the Advisory Board of the Wheaton College Center for Faith, Politics and Economics. Earlier in her career, she was Executive Director and General Counsel and later President of Americans United for Life, a national pro-life advocacy organization located in Washington, D.C. Cunningham and her husband Jay have three children and seven grandchildren.
