The Marion Philharmonic Orchestra will feature the Chamber Winds and guest artist Dr. Leon Harshenin in its fourth concert of the 2015-16 season, scheduled Saturday, March 5, 2016, at 7:30 pm, in the Butz Carruth Recital Hall at Taylor University.

The Chamber Winds will perform the serenades of Mozart and Dvorák. Dr. Leon Harshenin, Professor of Music and Piano at Taylor, will join the ensemble for Beethoven's Quintet for Piano and Winds.
