



A Sacred Roots Study Group is a simple way to develop Christian leaders like A. W. Tozer and Howard Thurman.






I. Our Vision: Toward Ten Thousand "Tozers" and "Thurmans"

#### A. Introducing Tozer

- At nineteen, he began to preach, becoming one of the most influential pastors in his generation.
- 3. His books, The Pursuit of God and The Knowledge of the Holy, have helped millions know and love the Triune God revealed in Scripture.









- These teachers were a list of thirty-five Christian spiritual classics Tozer read and reread throughout his life.



  - A. The Sacred Roots Spiritual Classics (SRSC) are not meant to be read alone; indeed, it is impossible to do so







    - Whatever benefit you find in reading will be doubled when you share it with a friend.






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
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    - Whatever benefit you find in reading will be doubled when you share it with a friend.

    - Resolve to never read a SRSC alone.














#### Research Results

- According to Sacred Roots' 2022 survey, 69 percent of congregational leaders recognize the signs of stress and burnout within themselves.
- Additionally, 25 percent were discontented with their friendships and 32 percent were dissatisfied with other relationships.
- When asked in what primary areas congregations need the most support or assistance, by a margin of 20 percent the two selected answers were "pastoral care strategies" and "faith/spiritual formation."






According to Sacred Roots' 2022 survey, 69 percent of congregational leaders recognize the signs of stress and burnout within themselves.








## Goal – to help congregational leaders to flourish in ministry

- Four pathways to this kind of flourishing are: family, work, education, and religious communities or congregations.

## Sacred Roots Research: Our Sample

- Size 48 congregational leaders.
- Age average 50 yrs.
- Gender 87% M, 13% F.
- Ethnicity Asian, Black, White, Hispanic, African.
- Multicultural, multiethnic population.
- 75% from churches of 250 or less.
- Mostly Urban (70%).






#### Findings of Our Work

- One major finding was the impact of close relationships on congregational leaders. While the pandemic disrupted interactions, the act of meeting in small groups was a key source of growth and transformation for congregational leaders. A majority of participants found that their congregational leader groups were a significant source of friendship and support (76%) and they plan to continue these relationships over the long-term (88%).
- Deep friendships across denominational, ethnic, gender, and age differences were developed that helped develop and sustain a sense of flourishing or thriving.

#### A. Preparation

- 1. Commit your group to prayer.
- Read the assigned SRSC chapter(s) well before your study group meeting.
- Contextualize the discussion questions.
- Learn about your leaders.
- Watch the SRSC videos at SacredRootsMinistry.org






- IV. Tips for Facilitating a Sacred Roots Study Group
  - B. Before the Meeting
    - 1. Determine when, where, and how long you will meet.
    - 2. Pick a suitable location.
    - Communicate logistics to your group.
    - 4. Clarify expectations for group members.






- IV. Tips for Facilitating a Sacred Roots Study Group
  - C. During the Meeting
    - 1. Arrive early to set up the space.
    - Greet your leaders as they arrive.
    - Allow time for spiritual friendship among your group.
    - 4. Spend time in prayer.
    - 5. Transition to discussing the spiritual classic.

  - D. After the Meeting
    - 1. End the meeting on time.
    - Consider being available after the meeting.




