Upland, Indiana - - - Four Taylor professors
will teach courses in the Kokomo Extension program of Indiana
University, Dr. Milo A. Rediger, Academic Dean and Interim
President, has announced.

Dr. Paton Yoder, Professor of History and Political Science, will teach a course in World History, and Dr. Julius Valberg,

Associate Professor of History and German, will teach a beginning course in the Russian language.

A course in English will be given by Professor Herbert Lee, and Professor Dalton Van Valkenburg, Assistant Professor of Business and Economics, will teach accounting.

All will teach in the Kokomo Extension Center except Mr.
