Upland, Indiana - - - Dr. Milo A. Rediger,

Academic Dean and Interim President of Taylor University, has been named a coordinator for the Commission on Liberal Arts Education of the North Central Accrediting Association, for the third consecutive year.

Dr. Rediger is one of 8 coordinators, who will visit a total of 82 colleges in the North Central region during the 1959-60 school year to study their programs and make recommendations for academic improvement.

Coordinators are chosen by the sub-committee on Liberal Arts

Education of the Commisssion on Research and Services of the North

Central Association.

Dr. Rediger has been Academic Dean of the college for 10 years and Professor of Philosophy and Religion since 1943. He is a member of the National Education Association, American Association of University Professors, and the National Association of Biblical Instructors. In addition he is listed in Who's Who in American Education.

He was named Interim President of Taylor by the University

Board of Trustees last June.
