Student enrollment at Taylor

University for the fall semester reached a new all-time record of 725, Dr. Milo A. Rediger, Academic Dean and Interim President, has announced. Of this number 260 are freshmen and 69 are transfer students from other colleges.

Women hold a slight edge in numbers with 367 enrolled compared with 358 men.

Taylor students have come from 39 states and represent over 30 religious denominations. In addition, young people have come to Taylor from the following countries: Canal Zone, Chile, China, India, Trinidad, Korea, Japan, Belgian Congo, Canada, Honduras and Cuba.

Enrollment has increased 66% since 1953 when the student body totaled 438. Since then the number of students has increased each year. In 1954 the college had 542 students, in 1955 there were 559, in 1956 enrollment was 565, in 1957 there were 593 and in 1958 the total was 696.
