Annual Spiritual Emphasis

Week at Taylor University will be held October 5-11, with Dr. Bob Shuler, Jr. as speaker, Dr. Milo A. Rediger, Academic Dean and Interim President, has announced.

Dr. Shuler is pastor of the First Methodist Church at Santa Ana, California. He formerly held pastorates at the Hollywood Methodist Church and at Trinity Methodist, Los Angeles, and for three years was head of the Old Testament Department at Asbury Theological Seminary, Wilmore, Kentucky.

He is currently chairman of the World Service and Finance Commission of his conference and formerly served as chairman of the Commission on Evangelism and the Commission on Social Action.

Dr. Shuler holds the A.B. degree from Whittier College, California, the B.D. degree from Asbury Seminary and the Th.D. degree from the University of Southern California.

Spiritual Emphasis Week is the first of several major religious events which are held on the campus during the year for the purpose of providing spiritual enrichment and inspiration for the students.
