TV In Christian Life Probed

Would you watch TV 24 hours a day for over two years?

That isn't a figure from a marathon. It is the amassed time spent in front of the tube by today's average 18-year-old.

Although TV is just one influencing aspect of the media today, it was the focus of "Media," the second in the Contemporary Problems Series this year, held December 4-6 here at the Bible College.

The main goal of the Contemporary Problems Series, according to Chairman Jay Platte, was to inform the students of important issues that they are going to face when they get out into the world. And in the first of the "Media" chapels, Professor Beals laid out the most important thought by saying, "You can feed your soul or destroy it by what you read, hear, or see."

On day two, the film "TV and Thee" showed the tremendous communicative capabilities of TV and how they are used and misused. This

was followed by a time of discussion in small groups. On the last day, selected questions were answered by a four-man panel. Professor Birkey moderated. When he was asked how TV effects family life, he showed, through facts that with the false views, violence, sex, and slanted news, TV has plenty of ways to create contradicting opinions within the home. Along with the problems TV is causing with families, some Christians are letting their viewing time become more important than their walk with God.

What can we do to control the effects of TV? This was answered by Mr. Baxter who said that sometimes the parents should just turn off the TV and instead have a time of fellowship. Chairman Platte also contributed by encouraging the students and faculty to express their opinions as to what should be shown. He quoted results of pressure put on by some groups and posted a list of addresses to write to, but he also warned



us to use our heads and not be unreasonable in our demands.

After this program, students might very well be fearful about TV. However, George Paliotto, the student on the panel, held that not all TV programming is bad, but that we as Christians should be discerning and consistent in all areas, including our TV viewing.

She also made it clear that grades are not based entirely on skill, but also on individual effort on projects. The students get quite anxious for the grades to come out, she admitted, but that gives the course its excitement. The projects are done completely by the students; pre-packaged deals are not used because they don’t stimulate enough creativity. Mostly, the materials are what grade-schoolers use; this helps to expand creativity within limits that will be encountered in teaching. The only inhibiting factor is sitting by a Michaelangelo while you are doing a pop-bottle sculpture.

Mixing Marriage And School

. . .special love needed

So you want to get married? You think you can handle all of the situations that arise? You've taken "Marriage and Family": no problems for you.

But how does mixing marriage and school look from the other side? Is life a bed of roses—or thorns? Is it all "Cinderella" and "Sleeping Beauty" or more like "Beauty and the Beast?"

The married student is a different breed. Because he has more responsibility than most students, he is usually a much busier man or woman. Nine times out of ten, the husband or wife or both are working almost a full work week. They may also have a family to train up in the Lord, and that on top of coping with the pressures of school. They must spend hours upon hours doing Dr. Wes's theology assignments, or writing English or philosophy papers or reading fifty to a hundred pages of collateral to meet a deadline. Then there are those school functions that each one is required to attend. And then how to be alive to spend that all important time alone with God?

One thing that makes it possible to operate at peak efficiency is an understanding kind of love from the mate. Love can cover up many wrongs that come about through blowing up under pressures when things are going wrong. Love is that living force that is working when after a long day the husband comes home and finds a messy house because the wife was sick all day. This is the force that is working when the husband is too tired to take out the trash, rake the leaves, or do the other chores. Love is also needed when the husband doesn't come home till late because he had to finish his homework. Yes, there are many things in the married student's life that must be held together by the love of his or her mate.

It is hard especially on the wife. Her husband is in school or at work all day and then he has to come home to do homework. She feels left out because he has so little

time to be with her. Resentments begin to build up and a major battle can begin unless something is done. Tom Schindler, a senior, has given us some very sound advice. He says that one of the major helps he has found is to spend time with his wife even if it means an "8" on a paper, because your wife is more important than a grade.

Many times depression sets in: grades, studies, jobs and family responsibilities bog the student down and can almost pull him under. Then is the time to have a change of pace or to relax. Some may sit back and listen to their favorite music, go out and play their favorite sport, etc. Some can't relax unless they are doing something. Such a person is Ed Doerr, president of Married Students Association. Ed is taking eighteen hours of classes plus three hours of correspondence studies. His wife is also a parttime student. Both husband and wife work close to a forty hour week and they are the parents of five children ranging from seven to sixteen. Each morning between five and five-thirty the entire family rises and comes together for devotions before the workday begins. Three to five hours a day are set aside for Ed to be with the children. Needless to say, Ed is very close to his family.

After talking with several students, the main answer to the problems that come with mixing studies and married life is that one must make or take time to do things together. There is much self-discipline and perhaps even loss of sleep to make the two work together.
