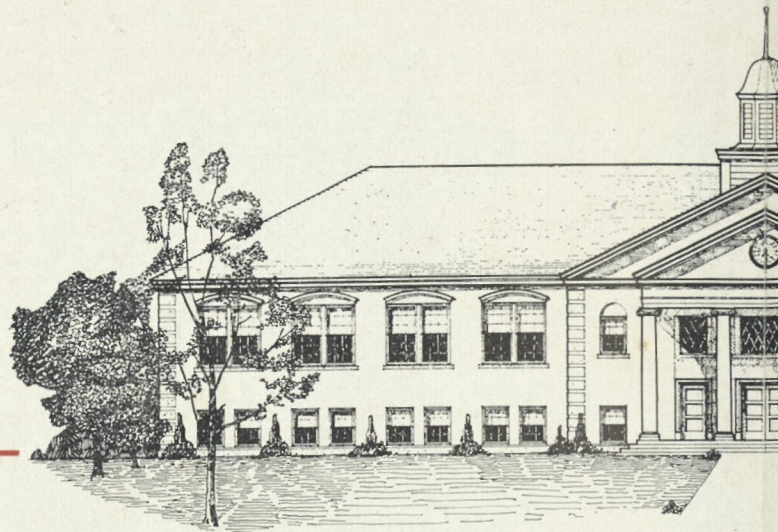

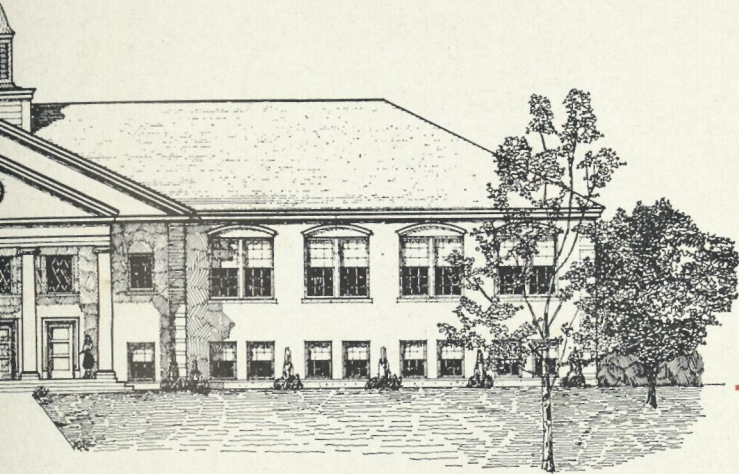
## What Can You DO NOW?
