MUCH ADO ABOUT NOTHING was written before the summer of 1600, and probably in 1598. In the Stationers' Register there is a casual note dated 4th August (1600) that four plays of the Lord Chamberlain's Company are to be staid, i.e., not printed. These plays were AS YOU LIKE IT, HENRY THE FIFTH, Ben Jonson's EVERY MAN IN HIS HUMOUR, and MUCH ADO ABOUT NOTHING. On the 23rd August, the play was regularly entered for printing, together with the SECOND PART OF HENRY THE FOURTH, as the property of the printers Andrew Wise and William Aspley. He had already printed Shakespeare's RICHARD THE SECOND, RICHARD THE THIRD, THE FIRST PART OF HENRY THE FOURTH. Soon afterwards a quarto was published. A replica of the title-page appears on the front page of this program.
