Dr. Don Gerig passed away February 23, 2010

Dr. Don Gerig, 70, who served as the final president of Fort Wayne Bible College and Summit Christian College prior to its connection with Taylor University, died Tuesday evening, February 23, 2010 following an illness. He became sixth president of Fort Wayne Bible College in 1986. In 1989, FWBC became Summit Christian College and he served as president there until 1992. Following his presidency at Summit, Gerig returned to the pastorate, serving at Huron Hills Baptist Church, near Ann Arbor, Mich., until his retirement in 2003. In addition to his presidential and pastoral roles, Gerig taught at FWBC, wrote curriculum in the area of pastoral management, published articles in a variety of publications and a book - Leadership in Crisis (1981). Dr. Gerig is survived by his wife Caroline. He is also survived by two children, Denise and Douglas, and six grandchildren.
