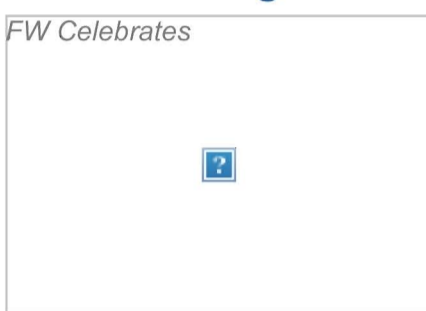


Along Rudisill...
