Alumnus Assists in Philippines

As a mail carrier, Steve Sherman g83 is required to deliver the mail come snow, sleet, or rain. He recently tested that motto delivering supplies, not for the US Postal Service, but to those who were impacted by Typhoon Haiyan that struck the Philippines earlier this month.

"The devastation we observed was sobering," Sherman said in a report on his Facebook page. "A movie production couldn't create a more effective war zone . . . the entire northern region of Leyte Island is truly a disaster."

Steve's team was able to deliver a flatbed of food and supplies to the village of Corba (which means "bend in the road") about 10 kilometers from Tacloban City. He and two other team members from Oregon, plus a Filipino doctor and nurse, went specifically to minister to a young pastor and his family who run a children's ministry.
