Dr. Pannell has dedicated his life to racial reconciliation and has written numerous books on the topic and is a notably gifted teacher, civil rights activist, and


evangelist—becoming the first African American trustee at Fuller University. He has also served on the Taylor Board of Trustees and was inducted last year in the
