# Institute of Evangelism and Bible Conference

April 27 — May 6

The Bible Institute that has been a feature of the Spring term at Taylor University for some time, will be held this year, April 27th to May 6th. This Institute is so valuable to all who attend it that the Faculty unanimously voted to continue it. A number of those who were in attendance last year have written back, expressing their very great pleasure and the good they got from the Institute.

The Bible teachers in this Institute are men and women who are specialists on the subjects they present. A church will be making an excellent investment to pay their preacher's way to this Institute. Sunday Schools could afford to send their teachers. The expenses are made so low that anyone can attend. Those who come from a distance can secure their board and room for \$5 a week, or \$6 for the entire ten days. All those who anticipate coming for the week or ten days, should secure accommodations in advance. Lectures on Bible, Prophesy, Doctrine, Preaching and Evangelism will be given and Evangelistic Services will be held every evening.

## Dedication

The most beautiful building on the Taylor University campus is the Swallow-Robin dormitory. It is a most comfortable home for the ladies and it will be a great memorial to those who have contributed to its construction. One of the greatest attractions during the Commencement week will be the dedication of this most valuable addition to the plant of Taylor University. Dedication will take place on the 12th of June, and all who are interested in this great work of Christian education, that can possibly be present, should witness this dedication. ## Normal Department

The Spring term of Taylor University will include the Normal Course in Class A. The school is prepared for the very best possible instruction in this line. A number of the teachers have been specially trained in Normal schools and are well qualified to make the department first class. Opportunities will be open to the teachers to take work in other departments.

## Domestic Science

One of the strongest departments of Taylor University is our Domestic Science Department. Our instructor is a graduate of a strong technical School. Those who come for the Spring term will have unusual opportunities in this department.

The Academy of Taylor is commissioned as a High School. If you have completed the Common School Course, you can do your High School work at Taylor. If you have completed a course in a Certified High School, you can enter Taylor and complete the High School course.

## Annuity Bond
